Our 12 small and comfortable Standard single rooms (12m²) come with 120cm-wide beds as well as bathrooms with showers.

The 59 Standard rooms (18m²) have 140-cm-wide queen size or twin beds.

Our 5 Family rooms are 21m² and equipped with twin beds as well as a sofa bed or an extra bed.

Our 30 Superior rooms are available for a supplement of € 35.- per night on the Standard room category. They are 24m² and offer the following additional amenities and services:
